Giancarlo Mazzanti

Founder - El Equipo Mazzanti – Colombia

Giancarlo Mazzanti (1963, Barranquilla, Colombia) is an Architect of the Javeriana University, Bogotá - Colombia (1987) with a postgraduate in Architecture history and theory, and Industrial design from the University of Florence, Italy (1991). He has been teacher in several Colombian Universities. He has also taught at some of the most prestigeous american Universities such as Princeton University in 2012 and Harvard Graduate School of Design in 2014. Amongst some of his most relevant projects are the Convention Center, Biblioteca España and the Southamerican Games Coliseums in Medellín, Colombia. Porvenir Kindergarten in Bogota and Timayui in Santa Marta.

He has been the distinguished winner of the Ibero-American Biennial in the category of Best Architectonic Work in 2008 (Lisbon, Portugal), winner of the Panamerican Architecture Biennial in the category of Architectonic Design in 2008 (Quito, Ecuador), winner of the Global Award for



Sustainable Architecture (Paris France) in 2010, chosen by the MoMA (New York, 2010) and the Museum Georges Pompidou (Paris, 2015) to exhibit his work in their permanent collection.







Murat Tabanlioglu

Tabanlioglu Architects - Turkey

Murat Tabanlıoğlu (RIBA, Chartered Member, Int'l. Assoc. AIA) studied architecture at Vienna Technical University and graduated in 1992. Besides his atelier program at Istanbul Bilgi University, he lectures at universities and various international platforms. In addition to his national and international contributions as a jury member, such as at AIA and WAF, Murat served on the Master Jury for the 2013 Cycle of the Aga Khan Award

for Architecture. In 2014 he has been granted with the great honor of curating the first Pavilion of Turkey at the 14th International Architecture Exhibition at the Venice Biennale. In 2015, he has been the curator of "Port City Talks. Istanbul. Antwerp." exhibition at MAS Antwerp, as a major event of Europalia 2015 Turkey.









Anouk Legendre

X-TU Architects - France

Anouk Legendere is associate and co-founder of XTU architects, a French agency developing a truly innovative approach to the city and the habitat, drawing inspiration from the strategies and processes of life. Among its remarkable achievements is the Jeongok Prehistory Museum in South Korea (prize of the Korean Academy of Architecture), the French pavilion of the Milano 2015 World Fair (Best Architecture Pavilion), Cite du Vin in Bordeaux (2016). Studying BayEcotarium in San Francisco, the NewBundDecathlon in Shanghai and the FrenchDreamTower in Hangzhou, flagship projects that synthesize in a unitary form, geographical integration and perspective of contents.

Owners of 3 technological patents in 2011, XTU has in particular invented and developed with the consortium SymBIO2, the system of 'biofaçades' (active facades integrating microalgae cultures). In 2016, XTU is Laureate of the competition

Reinventing Paris, for the project In Vivo including the 1st building of housing to biofaçades. The projects run by XTU offer another way of seeing the world and the certainty that we must change lifestyles: Architecture must anticipate the future!

Maurizio is a Senior Associate at Zaha Hadid Architects and has been working for the practice since 2002. In his presentation he will firstly introduce the current set out of the Office and then focus on the topic of the most recent Residential Projects, with an overview of the production of the last 10 years and more specific presentation of 3 case study projects in 3 different continents which he has personally directed.









Cinzia Ferrara

Ferrara Palladino Lightscape- Italy.

Cinzia Ferrara, architectural lighting designer, is the founder of FERRARA PALLADINO LIGHTSCAPE, lighting design firm based in Milan, Italy. She trained and practiced as an architect before deciding to focus on the special relationship between light and architecture. Concerned with dynamics of human space and the role that lighting can play, she works in a big variety of settings, interiors and exteriors of any kind, approaching lighting to all aspects combining creativity, technical know-how with innovative and original design solutions. In more than 25 years of activity, she has been working on a wide variety of projects for both public and private clients.
